**AALRR Partner Paul Loya
Inducted into ACHRO/EEO Hall of Fame**

Paul Loya, a partner at Atkinson, Andelson, Loya, Ruud & Romo (AALRR), was inducted into the Hall of Fame for the Association of Chief Human Resource Officers/Equal Employment Officers (ACHRO/EEO).
