Transgender and Title IX: The Current State of the Law and a Plan for Compliance

The rights of transgender students is a hot button issue receiving increased national attention. The US Department of Education recently released guidance clarifying that Title IX's prohibition of sex discrimination includes discrimination based on a student's gender identity or transgender status. This clarification corresponds to recent changes in California law that requires school districts to allow students to participate in athletics and use facilities consistent with their gender identity, irrespective of the gender listed on their records. However, school districts throughout the country and California are still grappling with competing concerns over how they handle transgender student issues. This briefing will provide an analysis of the current legal requirements regarding transgender students, including an overview of the current state of the law as well as analysis of recent and pending court cases addressing transgender students. The briefing will also provide a summary of the specific transgender issues that school districts face, including bathroom and shower access, athletic participation, field trip arrangements, as well as practical advice to address these issues before they become legal issues.
